Reptiles are some of the most interesting animals on the planet. Come check out our wide array of reptiles from all over the world from snakes to turtles to lizards!

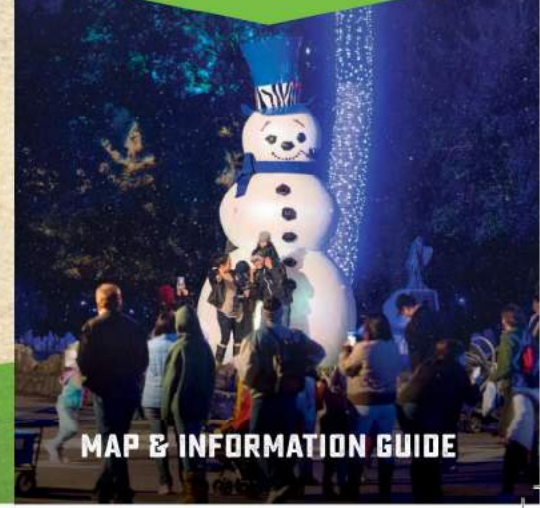
FUN FARM
