



Title 1 Funding - Self-guided Tour Field Trips

Through generous funding provided by community foundations, San Antonio Zoo is excited to award grants covering the cost of Self-guided Tour field trips to a limited number of Title 1 schools in the San Antonio Area.

Please read the eligibility requirements carefully and note the important information below.

School Requirements:

- Title 1 status
- Public or charter school
- Grades Pre-K through 12th
- Greater San Antonio Area
- Provide requested information (see below)

Field Trip Requirements:

- Registration for Self-guided Tour, at least 2 weeks prior to visit date
- Field trip occurs between September 10, 2021 and Feb. 28, 2022
- Field trip occurs on a weekday (Monday – Friday)

Application Process:

- Register for an eligible Self-guided Tour field trip
- Provide an estimated number of students and teachers
- Select “Yes” to the question, “*Would you like to apply for funding?*” and provide the requested information.
 - City Council District #
 - What percentage of students qualify for free lunch?
- Submit the Self-guided Tour registration by selecting, “*Complete*”
- Funding requests will be reviewed and, if approved, funding will be applied to your account
 - You will receive an email either confirming or denying your request

Important Information

- Teachers may apply for more than one field trip
- Funding is not guaranteed
- Completing the registration DOES NOT guarantee funding for your program
- Funding will be approved on a “first come, first served” basis
 - Only complete funding applications will be considered
 - All School Requirements criteria must be met
- Funding is not available for program add-ons or upgrades
- Funding is non-transferable
- Unused funding will be forfeited

All applicants will receive an e-mail notifying them of their application status. Please do not call to inquire about your application.

We expect to receive more requests than we can fulfill. Our goal is to approve as many applications as possible, but please understand that funds are limited.
